Reception

Thank you to all the parents who attended the parent workshop this week, I hope it was useful! Your children are now receiving a phonics recap sheet with the letter they have learnt each day, a 'love for reading' book and a reading record in their book bag. Please write in your child's reading record when you have read with your child or how they are getting on with the recap sheets. You also have a laminated sheet with all the phonic sounds we are learning and a QR code to show you how they are pronounced. We hope you enjoy reading and practicing phonics with your child, please do not hesitate to speak to a member of the Reception team if you have any queries.

Please note, that Reception children will have PE or an outdoor learning session on a Wednesday - this is the only day they should wear PE kit.

Years 1 and 2

Another busy week for years 1 and 2 with Octopus class (Mr Herdman) winning our attendance award this week. All the children have enjoyed having Tiddles the Tortoise in the KS1 Library area. The children also enjoyed creating book reviews of their favourite stories.
